History

- NCJ invents CW Sprint ... + SSB
- Internet RTTY Sprint → NA RTTY Sprint
- “Legal Dupe” rule
 - Increased QSO totals
 - ***Eliminated as of October 2008***
 - N1MM Logger already updated
 - WriteLog Beta updated
 - Win-Test feature request in the queue

Why a Sprint?

- Short contest period
 - ARRL DX – 96 hours!
- Level playing field – **QSY rule**
 - Big HP stations can't dominate
- Friendly: name & QTH
- FCC call sign requirement
- Meaningful exchange
 - Serial number; no RST
- Team competition

QSY Rule

- Must QSY after someone calls you
 - Answers your CQ, or
 - Calls after you finish prior QSO
- At least 1 kHz
 - To answer someone else's CQ
- At least 5 kHz
 - To call CQ yourself

Operating the Sprint

- Send at “your” speed
- Follow propagation: 20 → 40 → 80
 - Little guns delay band change 30 minutes
- Call CQ!
 - At beginning (big guns work each other)
 - Any time (can't find a new station)
- Alternate VFOs
 - Manage the QSY rule
 - Sync with a new QSO

Log Submittal

- Cabrillo format
- Log submittal:
 - NCJ web page
 - Email
 - Paper mail
- Log received web page
- Seven days (it's a sprint!)

Log Checking

1. Remove dupes
2. Check call signs:
 - a. Valid or unique
 - b. Busted (remove QSO)
3. Check exchange
 - a. Good
 - b. Bad (remove QSO)
4. Cross check
 - a. Good
 - b. NIL (Not-In-Log: remove QSO + penalty QSO)
5. Calculate score

DUPE CHECK RESULTS

N3XL is a dupe at QSO # 215
AE6RF is a dupe at QSO # 272.
K4GMH is a dupe at QSO # 237.

There was 3 dupes found.
You might have marked these dupes. For electronic logs, all dupes (marked or unmarked) are treated the same with no penalties.

CALLSIGN CHECK RESULTS

QSO # 46 K0LDS is a unique call. Received QSO# = 2.

QSO # 82 N0QX is a busted call. The correct call is N0QXW.

QSO # 86 W7THY is a unique call. Received QSO# = 1.

QSO #213 KW7M is a busted call. The correct call is KW7N

Number of unique calls = 4
Number of them judged to be busted = 2

EXCHANGE CHECK RESULTS

98.3% of your non dupe QSOs had their exchanges checked.

Number of bad exchanges = 0

CROSS CHECK RESULTS

QSO #106: QSO not found in log of N5ER
QSO #117: QSO not found in log of KE5OG
QSO #291: QSO not found in log of K5WW

68.6% of your remaining good QSOs were cross checked.

There were 3 bad cross check QSOs removed.
NIL Penalty of 3 QSOs will be assessed.
